A parent meeting will be held on October 15th at 7:00 pm in the school library where the presenters of this program will be available to explain the curriculum and answer any questions. This is an "opt-in" program. If you want to have your student participate in the program you must fill out and return the enclosed form. (Please be sure to read the forms carefully so that you do not confuse this program with the Formation in Christian Chastity form.)

If you have not had the opportunity to fill out the mailers associated with the Race for Education, please take the time to fill them out and send them back in to the school. This event is an important fundraiser for the school and is successful only if we have support from across the school community.

We move to the winter uniform for students on Tuesday, October 14th. Please refer to the handbook for any questions.
