



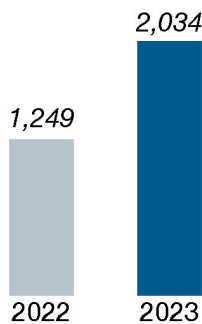
Dear Friends and Benefactors,

It has been a busy, productive, and exciting time for our Conference. Thanks to the generosity of our parish, parishioners, friends, and conference members, we assisted over 2,000 individuals with rent, utilities, prepaid grocery cards, and a range of other needs. Aided by our volunteer translators, our thirty-four active and associate members provided over 6,600 hours of volunteer service in the six zip code areas we serve in Annandale, Springfield, Burke and Fairfax. For this work, we were honored with a Best of Braddock award in December 2022. Last spring, we received a \$25,000 grant from Fairfax County, which, among other things, allowed us to develop a dedicated conference website ([svdphsconf.org](http://svdphsconf.org)). 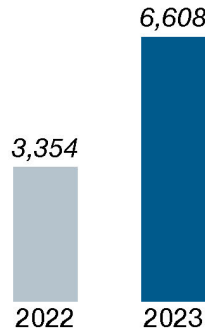

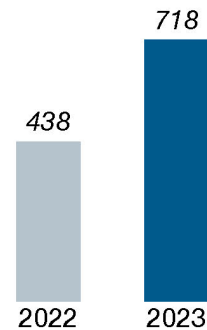
Individuals Served



Volunteer Hours

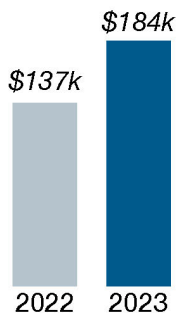

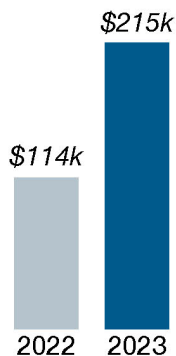


### Revenue and Disbursements

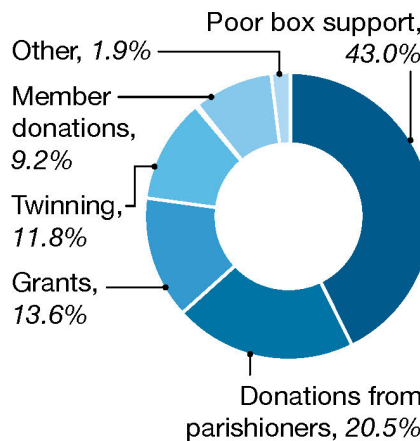
Total Revenue



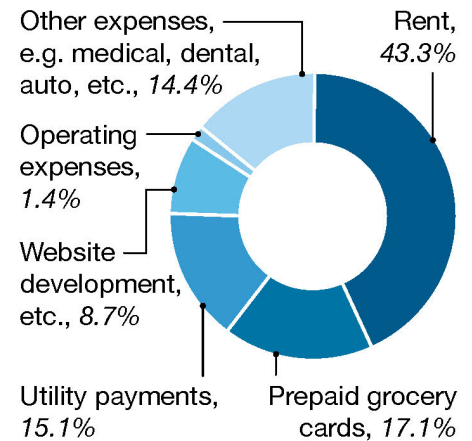
Total Disbursements
